The Guggenheim Museum Pass Guidelines

What is The Guggenheim?

The Guggenheim in New York City collects, preserves, and interprets modern and contemporary art, and explores ideas across cultures through dynamic curatorial and educational initiatives and collaborations.

What are The Guggenheim museum passes?

The passes allow Bradley Beach Public Library patrons to visit The Guggenheim for free! The pass admits up to four (4) adults or two (2) adults and two (2) children. Admission is free for children under twelve (12). Two (2) additional admissions may be purchased at the museum for \$5 per person. **Timed tickets are encouraged.** Call 212-423-3500 or visit www.guggenheim.org to book your visit. The passes are generously provided by the **Friends of the Bradley Beach Public Library.**

When is the museum open?

Sunday – Friday 11 am – 6 pm, Saturday 11 am – 8 pm. The museum closes at 4:30 pm on May 4 and will be closed May 24, November 23 (Thanksgiving), and December 25 (Christmas).

How can passes be checked out?

You will need a Bradley Beach Public Library card in good standing (i.e. in good standing and with less than \$5.00 in fines).

Can passes be reserved in advance?

Unfortunately, passes cannot be reserved in advance and are first come first serve. Patrons can call the library or check the online catalog (Search: Guggenheim Museum) to see if they are available, but the passes cannot be reserved. Passes cannot be renewed, either.

How long can the passes be checked out for?

Passes are checked out for two days.

How do I pick up passes?

Passes can be picked up at the circulation desk.

Do I need my library card to pick up the pass?

Yes, as with all library materials, bring your library card to check out the passes.

How do I return the passes?

Passes (including pouch, museum information folder, and passes) can be returned to the circulation desk or in the book drops.

What is the late fee or replacement fee?

There is no late charge for the pass. The charge to replace a lost museum pass is the value of the pass, which is **\$500**. A pass will be considered lost if not returned within 14 days of the due date. Passes brought back late may result in suspension of museum pass privileges for the patron.
